## National Chengchi University Regulations on the Use of Peer-to-Peer Software on Campus

Approved by the Information Security Promotion Committee on June 3, 2008 Amended and approved by the Information Security and Personal Data Protection Implementation Committee on October 27, 2016

- 1. In accordance with the letter Tai-Dian-Zi No. 0970077254 issued by the Ministry of Education and the resolutions of the 75th meeting of the TANet Technical Group, National Chengchi University (hereinafter referred to as the University) has formulated the *Regulations on the Use of Peer-to-Peer Software on Campus*.
- 2. The use of all peer-to-peer applications on the campus of the University is prohibited unless expressly permitted. Those wishing to use peer-to-peer applications may apply via the manual IP address of the University with permission from the relevant supervisor. - 3. Given the increasing popularity of peer-to-peer transmission technologies, the Computer Center of the University is authorized to appropriately approve essential peer-to-peer application services to meet the academic, educational, and administrative needs of the University.
- 4. All administrative, educational, and research units of the University shall cooperate in the regular peer-to-peer inventory and removal operations of the Computer Center.
  - The peer-to-peer inventory shall be included in the audit of information security and the protection of personal data at the University.
- 5. These Regulations were approved by the Information Security and Personal Data Protection Implementation Committee and submitted to the President for approval prior to implementation. The same applies to amendments.
